

# **Food** Distributions



God has been using the Food Distributions to unite the community. reconnect with active members from our past; besides the obvious: MEETING NEEDS! This has been a critical ministry during this crisis. It has demonstrated to our community that we are willing to help provide them with needed food, even if it means being out of our homes.

The demand has been increasing as the lockdown has continued. We have seen turnouts that provided assistance to around 700 people at our regular scheduled distributions; and over 500 people at an additional distribution that did not receive same amount of publicity (due to time constraints).

We have been blessed with funding from local families, ReMax Realtors, Clio Area Human Services Fund; besides the local congregations. Cost for a "Straight Truck" (around 8,000+ lbs of food) is \$600. During this crisis we are expanding to a semitruck (over 20,000 lbs of food) for our "regular" distributions.
