BUILDING THE KINGDOM Around the World



The vast majority of our contacts, are leaders working in difficult conditions with extremely limited resources. Things we take for granted: food, Bibles, chairs, roof, transportation; are blessings they pray for. We experience frustration in our circumstance, it would make sense they would also face discouragement at times as well.

God is using our sharing from our Daily Bible Reading to bring encouragement, support and help for these leaders. They will message their input, how God is using this ministry, or questions; to which we then respond. This encouragement and prayer has kept a preacher who goes from village to village, going; a leadership training program committed to carrying out their ministry, hope for orphans, ; preacher of new congregation motivated, and much more.

Seminars that we have provided for children in Pakistan (picture at right) and for adults (picture at top of article) provide encouragement, teaching and support.



Lessons we have learned from our walk (we can't do it; we have to rely on God; don't become discouraged in doing good, we will reap a harvest, etc.) have been

helpful to these fellow workers on the other side of the world.

We are also praying for workers who are presently in India and for those headed later this spring to Liberia for God to work through them!

We are continuing to monitor the response to our food distributions. We are noticing a decrease in turnout nad we are praying this is the result of more people getting "back on their feet". We have heard testimonies like that from some, but will continue to watch to determine the continued need for such assistance. Pray for God to give wisdom and clarity to how we continue this ministry.



Coming to Vienna Township in 2020, is a Habitat for Humanity build. These homes are done with volunteer labor. The recipient of the home has to provide over 200 hours of volunteering (on their home or for Habitat); and then will receive the home with a mortgage for the cost of materials (no interest is charged). The families are screened to assure that they will be able to afford the mortgage, utilities and living expenses once they move in.
