Last month we highlighted the changes that God had been making, that allowed us to have numerous resources for people to use in their own "home ministries" during the "lock down." We will be keeping those changes in place as we continue to see what our government(s) require.

We are thankful for the response of our people. This has enabled us to "stay in touch" and keep people aware of prayer needs, as they arise. The online streaming of services and posting of sermon videos has been extremely productive as we have seen a steady growth of people that are blessed. We went from our average worship attendance before the quarantine to over 30 people reached the first week.
