James will also emphasize: ACTIONS, not just words. James goes so far as to say, "Faith without works, is DEAD."

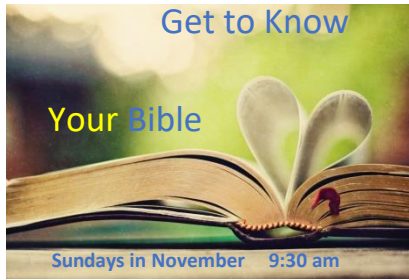
Spend time with God in His Word. Allow His Spirit to speak, guide and help you to grow. Then, find ways to serve Him more faithfully and abundantly!
