Take Time to Talk to God!

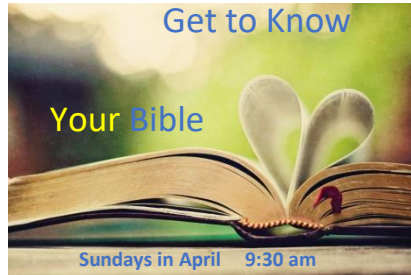
