If you find yourself in a position where you are caring for family/friends; you will discover that much will be demanded of you.

The initial work to get the individual home and set up can require coordination with doctors, installation of needed equipment, understanding of various procedures, development of schedules and more. THEN, the work really begins.

Developing a system/schedule that works is an early challenge. Adjusting to the new routine, and getting other "helpers" on board and worked into the schedule can be a challenge.

Once this is all in place, then you need to coordinate medical appointments, getting medications and treatments, besides the necessary food shopping and other incidentals.

This is all in addition to trying to maintain your own "life" and "home". You become aware that the need for "breaks" or "respite" is required not only for you; but the individual also needs to see and hear from others as well.

You pray and ask God for help, but He doesn't answer the way that you might expect. Many do not find "immediate healing" of the individual or people beating down the door to help.

God has provided you a place where you can find: encouragement, support, hope and strength. This is your local congregation. Your visit there results in discovering that people are praying for you and your family. People are genuinely interested in how you are doing. As you look around and listen, you will discover that there are others who are in similar situations and that you are not alone. They too, understand how there are times you feel: isolated, angry, frustrated, and without hope. Together, you can share ideas, lift each other up in prayer, encourage one another, or just sometimes safely "vent",

Far too often we see people STOP coming to worship; when they need it the MOST! It takes extra effort, time, energy to make it (especially if you are bringing the person you are caring along); which Satan can use as "excuses" for you. He knows how much it can help everyone (you, person you're caring for, the congregation, other caregivers) and this is why the devil works so hard to keep you away.

Pray, Commit and schedule and then work at joining with others this coming Sunday. Find the support, strength, encouragement, and hope that you need for the upcoming week. You will also discover that God has had the answer you need, waiting--- you just have to take advantage of it!
