Spending time in God’s Word each day helps you keep focused on priorities and how God wants you to live. You will discover that passages are easier to understand and God’s will is clearer.

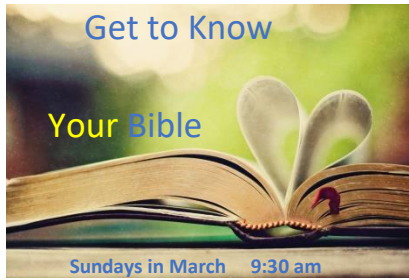
