THE BIBLE HAS A LOT TO SAY **ABOUT** REMEMBERING THE POOR! In the age of the Patriarchs, Job was described as a perfect and an upright man. Job said: I rescued the poor who cried for help, and the fatherless who had none to assist him. (Job 29:12) Moses wrote: There will always be poor people in the land. Therefore I command you to be open-handed brothers towards your towards the poor and needy in your land. (Deut. 15:11) Jesus said: The spirit of the LORD is on me, because he has anointed me to preach good news to the poor. (Luke 4:18) Those who have helped the poor will be rewarded on Judgment day.
