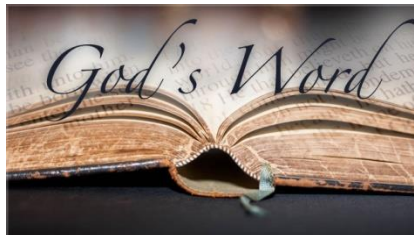

READING GOD'S LOVE LETTER

Ever seven years God had called for His people to gather and read His books of Law.

We are preparing as a congregation to read through the ENTIRE Bible in 2023 (some may opt to just focus on the New Testament, this time around). For some, this may be their very first time.

Over the past few years, we have read through the Gospels, or through through many of the New Testament Letters, various topics and this year have focused on many people of faith. Next year all that will be helpful as we look at the COMPLETE message God has given us.

Those that have "read through the Bible" in the past, have also found that "listening to it" was helpful. Cassette tapes were big years ago, now people are finding "podcasts" or other resources online.

The program will feature an Old Testament AND a New Testament passage each day. We are offering "tips", studies and other resources to help prepare people for this.

Our message each Sunday will come from the previous weeks reading. People are also welcome to bring questions that we will help them find answers to.

Start preparing now by getting used to reading on a daily basis.



TALKING WITH GOD

We are seeing more people discovering the power of prayer. They are also experiencing family members and friends that are asking them to pray for them.

We are active in encouraging our community to spend time talking with God, as evidenced by our leadership role in "National Day of Prayer" and promotion of the "See You at the Pole" (event in September encouraging school age youth to pray before school).

Growing in prayer includes not just bringing our "requests" to God, but also taking time and giving thought to saying "Thank You" for what He has already done, or "Praising" Him for who He is. We also discover that God is interested in every area of our life and nothing is "too menial" for us to share with Him.

From our talking with God, and allowing Him to talk to us through His Word, people see that it's all about developing a PERSONAL RELATIONSHIP with God. It's what He established with Adam and Eve in the Garden of Eden, and will continue through eternith with His people in Heaven.
