Winter presents unique challenges for this ministry. They do have some groups that serve at the National Parks during the winter months. They are also involved in planning and recruiting for the 2024 season.


Pray for God to work through the groups, give wisdom and guidance in the planning, prepare workers for the upcoming year and a support base that is reliable and sufficient for the task.
