We remain actively involved in helping people through the Clio Area Human Services. We provide monetary assistance as well as guidance and personal involvement.

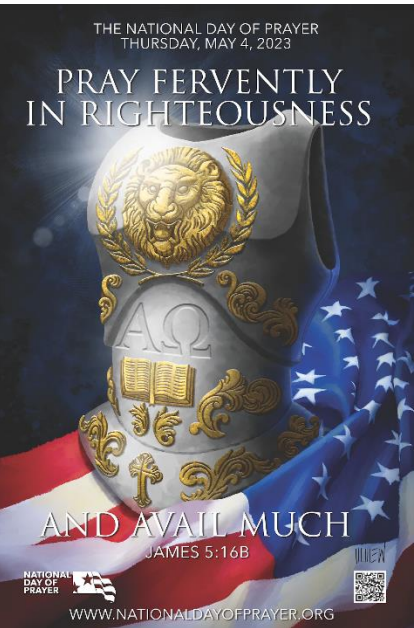
SUPPORT
