This month :

OLD TESTAMENT

Spent February reading about 40 years in the Wilderness, followed by March and the first 300 years in the Promised Land and now in April will be reading about the next hundred years as they transition to “kings”. Discover that David is about more than just a battle with Goliath and the importance of CONTINUING to walk with God!

NEW TESTAMENT

We will be spending the month in Luke’s record of Jesus’ life and ministry. Luke, a doctor, set out to put together an “orderly account”. He spoke to eyewitnesses and presents a chronological, biography of Jesus’ life and key people associated with it.

Our reading will focus mainly on Jesus’s ministry up until the final week before His Crucifixion. Rediscover His compassion, His teachings and His power. It can change the way you face each day!

REMEMBER: Write down any questions you might have and bring them on Sunday so you can ask them (at Bible School, or after worship!)



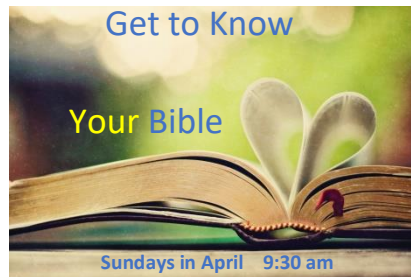
Take Time to Talk to God!
