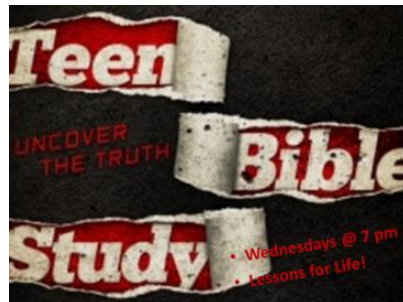


**Study & Pray**
