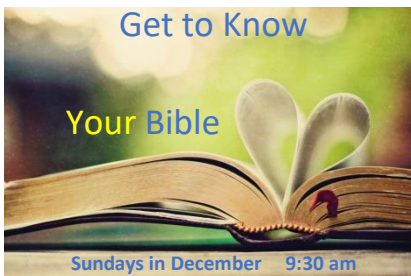

Sunday mornings at 9:30 we will meet and go over this material. All are welcome. You do not need to pre-register, there is no cost, we look forward to having you join us!

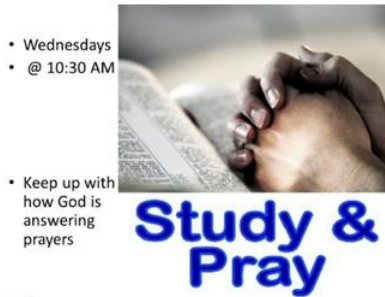
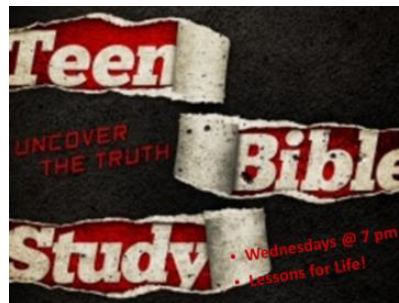


Figure 1 "Leviticus"
