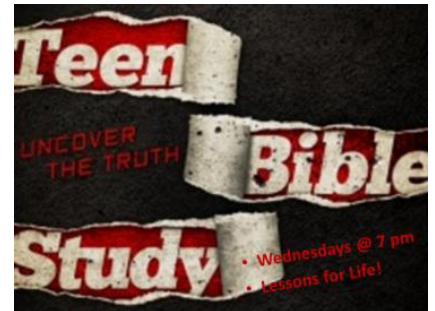


Study & Pray
