Distribution
Continues
in Flint



It began with the church family giving generously to help one of their own.. God has multiplied that gift to enable around 300 households per week to be helped with bottled water. About a dozen volunteers will gather on Mondays to go door to door delivering water to some neighborhoods affected by the contaminated city water.

Testing of several of the homes were done during November, to determine the quality of the water now that Flint is relying on Detroit to provide the water. The State and County Health Departments warned citizens to continue using filtered water after the change, as they are concerned about the lines being cleared of the contaminants. We hope to get the results of the tests back shortly and will then know how much longer we will need to continue to provide support. If help is needed for an extended period of time, a third truckload of water has been offered!

Families in the neighborhoods have been most appreciative and our workers have noticed improvements in the neighborhoods (friendliness, appearance, people wanting to help, expressing appreciation, etc.)


Bible Bowlers Prepare for 2nd Tournament of the Year!


Pine Run Raiders Sundays @ 9:30 AM
