Feast of Firstfruits

Exodus 22:29 Offerings from granaries and vats to be given to God.

Leviticus 2:11-15 Grain offering with salt (crushed heads of new grain roasted in fire. Oil and incense included with grain offering.

Leviticus 23:9-14 Brought from first harvest of grain. Offer sheaf, lamb (year old without defect), grain offering of 2/10 of ephah of fine flour mixed with oil, drink offering ( ¼ of a hin of wine); don't eat any bread or roasted grain from harvest until Firstfruit is given

Numbers 18:12, 13 First fruits are the best and given to Lord's servants

Deuteronomy 18:4, 5 Best given to the priests; the first fruits

Deuteronomy 26:1-11 First fruits given in Promised Land; remember how God delivered and has blessed

Nehemiah 10:35 People to bring first fruits each year

Proverbs 3:9 Honor the Lord with the first fruits

John 20:1-9 Jesus is risen from dead.

I Corinthians 15:4, 20-23 Christ is the fulfillment of the "first fruits". His resurrection is the First and He was presented to God. The rest of the harvest will come.

Romans 4:25 Died for our sins, raised for our justification.

James 1:18 We are a king of firstfruits; as believers
