

Feast of Unleavened Bread

Exodus 12:14-20	7 days eat bread without yeast 1 st Day-- Removal of Yeast, sacred assembly 7 th day—Sacred assembly No Work on these days, prepare food SIGNIFICANCE: CAME OUT OF EGYPT
Exodus 13:1-10	Day came out of slavery, eat nothing with yeast for 7 days and on 7 th day hold a festival. SIGNIFICANCE: CAME OUT OF EGYPT
Exodus 23:15	7 days eat bread without yeast. 1 st month SIGNIFICANCE: CAME OUT OF EGYPT
Leviticus 23:5-8	1 st month 15 th day; 7 days eat bread without yeast 1 st Day—Sacred Assembly, no regular work For 7 days offering to the Lord by Fire 7 th Day—Sacred Assembly, no regular work
Numbers 28:17-25	1 st day— Sacred assembly; do no work Present offering by fire (2 young bulls, one ram, 7 male lambs year old without defect With each bull—grain offerings of 3/10 of ephah of fine flour mixed with oil With ram—grain offering of 2/10 of ephah mixed with oil Each of 7 lambs—grain offering of 1/10 of ephah mixed with oil One male goat as sin offering to make atonement In this way prepare food for offering every day for 7 days 7 th day— Sacred assembly, do no work
Deuteronomy 16:1-8	Passover & Feast of Unleavened inseparable
Luke 22:7	Jesus observed Passover; He became the Lamb and would take away the sin
I Corinthians 5:7, 8	Christ the Lamb, get rid of the old “yeast” (malice & wickedness)
Matthew 16:6, 12	Yeast= False teaching

JESUS REMOVED ALL “YEAST” by being the sacrifice that literally took away the sins of the world.
