We were blessed to host the first two Food Distributions. Over 200 were helped at the first and 300+ were helped in January. The food varies each month based on what the Food Bank has available. We were able to provide: Apples, oranges, grapes, cucumbers, tomatoes, sweet peppers, breads, sweets and milk in January. Local agencies were able to distribute the surplus to Seniors in our area. We are grateful to the congregation for their patience with pallets, milk crates, etc. that were left until the Food Bank could return to get them.



We are thankful for the Clio Human Service's Fund and Kirk Todd Garage for providing funds to purchase trucks for the next two months which will bring meat along with other groceries to the area. The Distribution will be heading on to West Vienna United Methodist on the corner of W. Wilson and Webster Roads. They have
