Did you notice:

Galatians 2:1-10 Reference to the Jerusalem Council (Acts 15).

Galatians 2:11-21 If this is chronological in order, it would appear that this letter could not have been written immediately after the Jerusalem Council. Demonstration of the power of “peer pressure” and how it can take down even the most notable workers in the Kingdom.

Galatians 3:1-14 The emphasis of salvation by faith and not by works. Christ took our place and punishment.

Galatians 3:15-25 Law was given to show us the need for a Savior. Jesus is the fulfillment of God’s promise to Abraham.

Galatians 3:26 – 4:7 Baptism is when we are clothed with Christ. He is the one that unites us. We are not “servants” but co-heirs.

Galatians 4:8-20 Not the celebration of special days, but the reliance on those celebrations to “earn” our salvation that is condemned. Paul speaks the truth because of his sincere concern for them.

Galatians 4:21-31 Hagar and her son, were the result of “man” trying to accomplish the promise of God through their own efforts. This is why it is compared to those who try and earn their salvation through the keeping of the Law Sarah and Isaac were the result of God doing what ONLY HE COULD DO and fulfilling the promise This is why they are compared to salvation by faith in Christ and God’s grace.
