Did you notice:

Galatians 5:1-15 Trying to earn your salvation can jeopardize your faith. Our faith will be demonstrated through the love that we show to God and others. Paul expressed his frustration with the false teachers and makes it clear that God will deal with them as He sees fit.

Galatians 5:16-26 Easy to determine if you are following the flesh or the spirit. Which of these lists best describes your daily life. Paul also goes on to warn about becoming proud or conceited about one's life of service.

Galatians 6:1-10 The Apostle makes it clear that Christians have a responsibility to help one another to walk with Jesus. He gives guidance on how to help those that are struggling with sin. Dangers include being judgmental, falling prey to temptation as well, becoming proud. Though we are to be helping one another, ultimately we are responsible for our walk with the Lord. Paul reminds that a man "reaps what he sows" AND encourages people not to be discouraged and give up hope. He reminds that God will bless the efforts.

Galatians 6:11-18 Paul concludes the letter reminding them that even the false teachers are unable to "earn their salvation". Instead, we need to glory in God's grace and Jesus, who died to make it possible.
