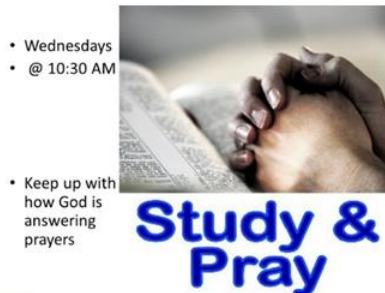


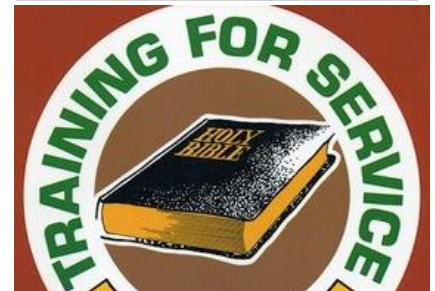
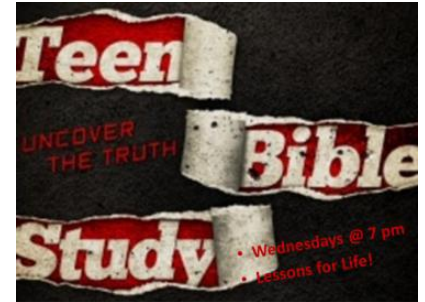
Figure 2 Study of the Galatian Churches
