Revelation Chapter 17:

We find in this chapter that the "great prostitute" is punished for leading others into sin. Exactly who this prostitue is, we can't be sure, but there is a lot of guessing about it. No matter who or what it is, let it suffice to say that when something leads people away from God tht it will be destroyed in the end!!

A further explanation of her physical description is given in verses 9-12. Who the kings are or what 7 hills are meant, is speculation. However, the prostitute will be responsible for leading people into sin, the persecution of Christians and has received power from Satan. She will work together with the beast and will lead man into battle against God and His forces.

As frightening and powerful as the prostitute may appear, God shows John that the Lamb will overcome, the prostitue will end up being destroyed by the ones she led, because this is God's will and He is in charge.

Revelation Chapter 18:

This Babylon which leads others into sin, is the same as the great prostitute (Compare Rev. 17:1-4 with 18:3,16). Therefore, the destruction of this one force, is described again here. So certain is its destruction, that it is spoken of al already having happened. We see that many have joined in with the prostitue in the sins that she commits.

God's people are called out and are told that she will be punished for all the sin and torment that she has committed. Those who partook with her, will separate themselves from her and lament her passing. Those who have marketed items used for her overindulgence and sins will be saddened because their profit will be lost. Those who brought her needs will also weep and mourn.

This force, it seemed to have everything; yet it will be destroyed quickly and surely. For that reason, God's people will be able to rejoice for God will have judged her for her treatment of His people.

We see that the destruction will be final and complete at is the force that the prostitute represents will never be given power or authority again.
