Did you Notice:

Luke means "light giving"

Luke 1:3 Luke had researched and was organizing the material he had gathered on the Life of Jesus of Nazareth.

Acts 1:1 Luke refers to his "former book" about Jesus' life and ministry. Luke now picks up with the events surrounding Jesus' ascension and early history of the church.

Acts 16:6-10 On the Apostle Paul's second Missionary journey they had traveled throughout Asia Minor. It appears at Troas, that Luke joins the group.

Acts 16:11-16 Luke was with them for the trip to Philippi, but it appears that he stays there, when they moved on to Thessalonica.

Acts 20:5-7 It appears that Luke joined Paul on the 3<sup>rd</sup> Missionary journey around Philippi. The Apostle was headed on his way back to Jerusalem for the feast. Luke was present at Troas when Paul healed Eutychus.

Acts 20:13-15 Luke and some others go on ahead of Paul to Assos where they were to meet Paul.

Acts 21:1-6 Luke sails with Paul to Tyre. They were encouraged not to continue on to Jerusalem, but they moved on regardless.

Acts 21:7-16 Luke travels with the Apostle Paul from Tyre to Caesarea. They headed from there to Jerusalem.

Acts 21:17-19 Luke accompanied Paul as he met with James and the elders in Jerusalem.

Acts 27:1,20, 27 Luke joins Paul on the ship headed to Rome.

Acts 28:1 Luke made it safely to Malta.

Acts 28:11-16 Luke makes the trip with Paul to Rome.

Philemon 24 Luke fellow worker with Paul during first imprisonment.

Colossians 4:14 Luke, the Doctor was with Paul during first Roman imprisonment.

2 Timothy 4:11 Luke is with Paul during Paul's second imprisonment.
