NEED FOR DIALY BIBLE READING

METHODS OF BIBLE READING AND STUDY

- 1. Character Study (Read and study about a person)
- 2. Topical Study (Read and study about a topic)
- 3. Overview Study (Read large sections quickly to get an idea what the section is about)
- 4. Book Study (Read and focus on one Bible book)
- 5. Memorization (Find verses helpful in your life and memorize words and where found) Suggested Format:
 - 1. Begin with Prayer
 - a. Ask God to help you understand
 - b. Ask God to help you apply
 - 2. Quickly read the passage to gain an overview
 - 3. Re-read the passage
 - a. Write down Main Events or Topic being discussed
 - 4. Contemplate what lessons you can learn from this passage
 - 5. Pray that God will help you apply what you have read
 - 6. Tell someone what you have learned within the next 24 hours
