October Distribution. A decrease in amount of food we received resulted in our people getting about 1/3 their normal supply.

We were thankful to be able to offer a second distribution on October 26th. An area agency and groups made this possible. This time we received an entire semi-truck. Bethany United Methodist rose up to volunteer to host this event.

We were grateful to receive a check for \$1200 from the Clio Farm Market. They were hampered this year and have discontinued. We continue to receive support from area churches and pledges from people in the community.
