Obadiah 1

The Edomites (descendants of Esau and enemies of Israel) had gone and joined in the looting of Jerusalem in 586 B.C. Because of this, God would destroy them, even though they considered themselves invincible. They would be completely erased, having no survivors (accomplished hundreds of years later).

Judah, on the other hand, would be restored and given back their land.
