Did you Notice:

Timothy: means "honoring God"

2 Timothy 1:5 Mother and Grandmother had probably met Paul on his 1st Missionary journey and become believers.

Acts 16:1-5 On this second missionary journey of Paul, he returns to cities from his first journey and finds Timothy; a believer. He recruits Timothy to come and work with him. Timothy quickly became a co-worker and not just an "intern".

Acts 17:14, 15 Timothy worked with Silas, in Paul's absence.

Acts 18:5 Timothy is considered an equal member of the team and assists in the work of evangelizing and discipling.

Acts 19:22 This time, Timothy is listed first, along with Erastus and they are going ahead and preparing the work to be done.

Acts 20:1-5 Timothy is part of a large contingent heading with Paul to take an offering to the church at Jerusalem.

Romans 16:21 Timothy is proclaimed to the Romans as a "fellow worker".

I Corinthians 4:17 Timothy is entrusted with representing the Apostle Paul and able to do the work that is needed.

I Corinthians 16:10,11 Timothy is to have the same support that the church would provide for Paul.

2 Corinthians 1:1, 19 Timothy was a co-worker and co-preacher with Paul.

Philippians 1:1 Timothy is presented to Philippians as a co-worker with Paul.

Philippians 2:19-23 Paul views Timothy as a "son" in whom he has complete confidence.

Colossians 1:1 Timothy is presented to Colosse as a co-worker in Christ.

I Thessalonians 1:1 Timothy is listed, along with Silas; as a co-worker of Paul.

I Thessalonians 3:1-13 Timothy was sent to carry on the work that needed to be done. He reported back on the faithfulness of the believers in Thessalonica.

2 Thessalonians 1:1 Timothy again listed with Silas as a co-worker of Paul.

I Timothy 1:2-4 Timothy was entrusted with authority and was sound in faith to recognize and address false teachers.

I Timothy 4:11-16 Timothy had been "ordained" and given a spiritual gift that enabled him to inspire others by his preaching, teaching and life.

I Timothy 6:12, 20, 21 He is encouraged to fight for and guard the faith.

2 Timothy 1:2 Paul refers to him as a "son".

2 Timothy 4:9-13, 19-22 Timothy has authority and familiarity with numerous workers in the ministry. He is entrusted with carrying out Paul's most earnest wishes.

Hebrews 13:23 Timothy was imprisoned for his faith. We have no record of when or how Timothy died.
