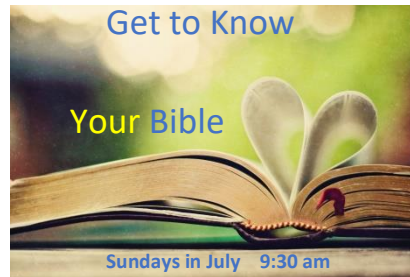
Continue to pray for one another. All of our families have issues, or their “extended” families; and pray for God
