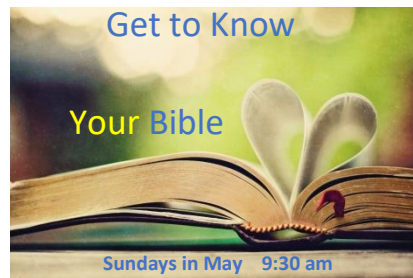
been designed by the National Day of Prayer.
